### **Time Commitment**

Both the R&D Team Member and Registration Chair roles should take up just a couple hours every week during the school year with a slight increase in May, as competition day approaches.

The Innovation Committee Member and Graphics Designer roles have a similar time commitment, but the bulk of work will be January and February, with lighter work in March, followed by increased work in April and May. Members of the Innovation Committee will be particularly critical for competition day in late May.

The webmaster role is more flexible, but the sooner we transition to a redesign the greater the exposure your new design will have!
